LAWN & GARDENS

There is no money in the budget for mulching again this year. There is just too much wood repair and painting to be done. DO NOT plant flowers if you aren't going to take care of them. Weeds will be sprayed. DO NOT TOSS CIGARETTE BUTTS ON THE GRASS OR IN GARDENS. WE RECENTLY HAD MULCH CATCH FIRE FROM A CIGARETTE BUTT!! PARENTS: Please instruct your children that there is to be NO bike riding on the grass and NO climbing in trees!! PLEASE DO NOT SIT FLOWER POTS ON RAILINGS. They cause the wood to rot! This will be strictly enforced this summer! Dog leashes are not permitted on sidewalks, lamps or grassy areas. If a lawnmower is damaged by a leash the homeowner will be charged for the repair. YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER AND LEASH YOUR DOGS. This is a STATE LAW as well as a rule in the condo documents. Lawn care will not mow where there is animal waste. If your car is leaking oil, please throw some clay kitty litter in the area to keep the blacktop from deteriorating. Spray the green mildew with Clorox or Round Up and it will disappear. Shrubbery will be trimmed in July. If you do not want yours trimmed, please tie a plastic bag or sign on them.

TRASH

Save yourself some money...if you are able to pull a weed or pick up a piece of trash...please do! It is your money that Council is spending. **HELP** is needed after a windy day! Please help upright the recycle bins and pick up the trash. Also, keep lids on the dumpsters closed. **It is a violation of the documents to store furniture and appliances on your patio.** Council has done an inspection and many patios are eyesores! Please clean them up! Penn Waste will take large items placed beside the dumpster each week.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Pets cannot run loose in the community. Call the animal control officer @732-5660 for violations! There are to be only (2) pets per unit. Tenants are not permitted to have pets! If you do not have a copy of the rules and regulations, please call the office @732-3061. All landlords are required to provide Council with names and phone numbers of tenants. There are to be no signs of any kind posted in Westwood Village. If you have a problem with your neighbor, it is your job to work it out or call the police. THERE ARE TO BE NO CHARCOAL GRILLS ON THE SONOMA BUILDING PATIOS. Please refer to the Rules & Regulations for more information!

MAINTENANCE

The maintenance contractor will soon be done with the wood repair to the brown units. Work will begin on the Sonoma Buildings and painting will start over as soon as we get done with the ones that have been repaired. Council appreciates your patience. Concrete work will be done as funds are available. Since we no longer have a fall mailing, please make a note to have a bag of ice melt available for use until the snow

crew arrives! Rotted wood takes priority! Fogged windows must be inspected by a Council member to receive reimbursement.

PARKING

There is a parking issue in Louise Court. The guest parking spaces are limited. If you have several cars, please be considerate to your neighbor and park a car over on Brian Drive so some spaces are available for guest parking. Council thanks you for your cooperation!

SAFETY

You are reminded to report any suspicious activity to the E. P. police @732-3633. The speed limit is 15mph in Westwood Village. If you would like a reflective house number, please call East Pennsboro Ambulance @732-5552. They will install it for a donation of \$15. If you live alone, please give Council an emergency contact number.
